

CensorCut

User Manual



Overview

CensorCut is a plugin effect for censoring profanity or unwanted words in lyrics by replacing the offending content with a **censor bleep** or by crypting the audio signal.

It has to be used as insert effect : you can trigger the effect with the parameters (on push button & one toggle button) or with a MIDI tracks assigned to the effect.

Censor Cut is a VST plugin for Windows : you need a host application like Cubase, Sonar, Vegas Pro, FL Studio etc.. for using it.

Installing

Just copy the .dll file to your VST plugin folder.

CensorCut.dll is the 32 bit version for Windows

CensorCut64.dll is the 64 bit version for Windows

Using the plugin

Load it as insert on the audio track / bus / master you want to censor.

CensorCut has two modes : Beep! & Crypt!


Crypt mode

This is the default mode, the plugin process the audio and encrypt the signal.

click on the "X" logo  to toggle ON / OFF the Crypt mode.

Beep mode

This mode only works when Crypt mode is off : a censor bleep is inserted (replace the audio

signal) when you play a MIDI note, on click on the "-18" logo 
The duration of the beep is determined by the time you hold the button (or the MIDI note)

Automating your censorship

The logo buttons are automatable parameters, you can access these parameters in your sequencer. You can also send a MIDI track to the plugin for playing the beeps.
