Speak N Spell 80

User Manual



Overview

SpeakNSpell80 is a plugin instrument for recreating the sound of the good old Speak And Spell toy from the late 70's and 80's.

Use the MIDI keyboard to trigger words or letter: in "assing" mode, each MIDI key trigger a different word. Or use the special mode to concatenate words and play with the MIDI keyboard.

You can use the pitch bend command to change the pitch of the audio output while playing. SpeakNSpell80 is a VSTi plugin for Windows: you need a host application like Cubase, Ableton Live, Sonar, Vegas Pro, FL Studio etc.. for using it.

Installing


Just copy the .dll file to your VST plugin folder. SpeakNSpell80.dll is the 32 bit version for Windows SpeakNspell8064.dll is the 64 bit version for Windows

Using the plugin

Load it as instrument on any MIDI track of your sequencer. Speak N Spell 80 has two modes : Assign & Synth

Assign mode

This is the default mode: the sounds are mapped to the MIDI keys: each note trigger a different word: right click on the keyboard to assign any word to the note between F-2 and B-4. or use the "random!" button to assign random words to each note.



Synth mode

With this mode you can construct "phrase" and play with ther keyboard : now the keys affect the pitch of the audio.

double click on the words in the list to insert the word in the phrase. use the a-b-c keyboard to insert single letter or numbers
